



Immigration Requirements to work

To work in New Zealand you must have:

- A work permit
- Permanent New Zealand residency or citizenship

If you have a visitors or student visa and obtain a job offer, contact the New Zealand Immigration Service to obtain a work permit or New Zealand residency.

Immigration Requirements for Self Employment

Having a Long Term Business Visa/Permit allows self employment in New Zealand. It can be extended for up to three years to provide sufficient time to establish your business prior to applying for New Zealand Residence

To be eligible for a Long Term Business Visa (LTBV) you will need to show that you have:

- Business experience
- Investment funds
- A good understanding of your proposed business and the New Zealand business environment
